




## **Georgia Compact Progress**

- ★ Regional Infrastructure Rehabilitation Project: Road Rehabilitation: Construction season for 2009 is set to begin this quarter. MCG is working to complete two major procurements of the road funded by the Compact Amendment in January 2009.
- ★ Energy Rehabilitation Activity: Construction works are underway on the second phase of rehabilitating the North-South Gas Pipeline. At present, MCG is procuring goods and a works contractor for Phase III. MCG is considering adding a Phase IV due to the success of the first two phases.
- ★ Enterprise Development Project: Georgia Regional Development Fund (GRDF): The GRDF had another strong quarter from January to March 2009 making over \$5 million dollars in new investments. These include investments in companies that produce and distribute concrete as well as a fish processing company.
- ★ Agribusiness Development Activity (ADA): The ADA continues to match grants to small and medium agribusinesses throughout Georgia. The Millennium Challenge Georgia Fund has signed 154 grant agreements and committed approximately \$7 million dollars to assist primary producers, value-chain initiatives and farm service centers grow their business to stimulate economic growth.


## Compact At-A-Glance


