



Lesotho Compact Progress

- ★ Water Sector Project: Metolong: A critical donors meeting to discuss funding of the Metolong Dam was held in Maseru in March 2009, chaired by the Minister of Finance and Development Planning. The attendees included: BADEA (Arab Bank for Economic Development in Africa), Saudi Fund, Kuwait, the World Bank, the European Commission, MCC, the Metolong Authority and MCA-Lesotho. In response to the shortfall of funds identified, a strategy was agreed upon to help keep the implementation of the project moving forward.
- ★ Health Sector Project: Significant progress has been made on the Health Project. MCA-Lesotho and the Health Project Implementation Unit are nearly fully staffed and undertaking all needed

- project implementation actions. The procurement process for the Health Systems Strengthening and Medical Waste activities was launched in mid-March with evaluations scheduled for early June 2009.
- ★ Private Sector Development Project: A vendor has been selected to provide payment services for the Automated Clearing House activity. This vendor has been providing similar services to South Africa, which will help facilitate the cross-border payments. The Smart Card activity will provide financial services to the rural poor and is progressing well. This project includes outreach activities throughout the country.




