


Morocco Compact Progress

- ★ Program Set-Up: The compact program is being administered by the Agency of Partnership for Progress (APP), an independent, public entity and led by a mixed public-private board of directors. All Project Directors are in place as are formal agreements with the seven public entities responsible for implementing the projects.
- ★ Fruit Tree Productivity Project: In March 2009, twenty Farmer Associations across seven provinces began planting over 600,000 olive trees on almost 5,500 hectares of erosion-prone hillsides. In addition to providing sustainable and increased revenues to poor farmers, the trees and soil conservation measures will help stem future erosion.



- ★ Financial Services Project: APP signed an agreement with the Jaida microfinance investment fund to provide up to \$25 million in loans, helping support Moroccan microfinance institutions.
- ★ Artisan and Fez Medina Project: Market analysis is being carried out to determine potential uses of historic sites that would contribute to reducing poverty in the medina of Fez, the oldest section of the city.
- ★ Enterprise Support: The public entities responsible for implementing the project began to receive training in order to improve their capacity to support small start-up businesses.
