

Burkina Faso Compact Progress

- ★ **Program Set-Up:** The Compact is expected to enter-into-force in July, signaling the beginning of the implementation phase for the 5-year program.
- ★ **Rural Land Governance Project:** Procurements are underway for baseline data collection on land conflict and land tenure security, to enable monitoring of project performance. In March, the Burkina Faso submitted the proposed new rural land tenure law to Parliament, as a result of workshops and legal drafting support financed by pre-Compact grant funds from MCC.
- ★ **Roads Project:** Evaluations are underway for the project management and technical assistance contract as well as the final

design and environmental and social assessment contract for the Dedougou-Nouna-Mali border road.

- ★ **Agriculture Development Project:** The management audit of the Sourou Valley Development Authority is complete and MCA-BF will now develop an action plan for the development authority to implement. Evaluations are underway for the project management contractor for the Water Management and Irrigation Activity, as well as for the feasibility study, design and environmental and social assessment studies and supervision of works at Lery and Di.

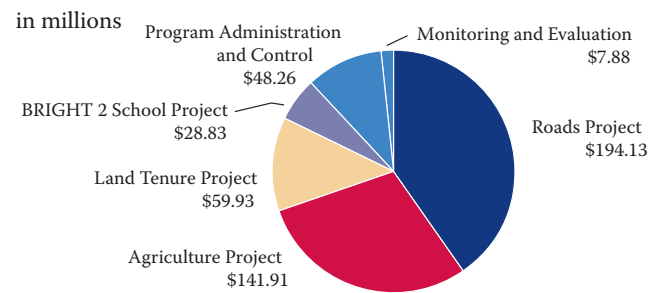
