Low-Level Radioactive Waste Transportation Display at the Pahrump Community Library

The U.S. Department of Energy, National Nuclear Security Administration Nevada Site Office, Environmental Management low-level radioactive waste transportation display is currently on exhibit at the Pahrump Community Library through January 20, 2004. The display depicts low-level radioactive waste shipment routes to the Nevada Test Site used by approved waste generators from July 1, 2003, through June 30, 2004.

Other information presented in the exhibit includes an explanation of what low-level waste is, how waste packages are identified and shipped, how routes are selected, and information on the Emergency Management Grant Program.

Also on display is a mock disposal drum showing non-radioactive examples of items commonly disposed of as low-level radioactive waste at the Nevada Test Site.

The public and media are invited to visit the display at 701 East Street, Pahrump, Nevada. Library hours are 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Friday and Saturday.
