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Executive summary

Contract change

On April 28, 2006, NYU Medical Center was notified that it had won the NN/LM contract for the Middle Atlantic Region for 2006-2011. This contract change was the first shift in RMLs in the region in over 35 years. NYU is honored to have the privilege of serving network members and the region for the next five years. A formal announcement of the change in RMLs was sent out to local library listservs.

Personnel

In July 2006, Kathel Dunn formally accepted the position of Associate Director, NN/LM Middle Atlantic Region. Formally Head of Public Services at the Ehrman Medical Library, Ms. Dunn approaches the job with experience in private and public academic health sciences libraries, a collaborative and goal-oriented management style and research interests in continuing education; and scholarly publications ranging from grey literature to the values of scientists as expressed through peer-reviewed literature.

NYU staff supporting RML work

While the process of hiring new RML staff was underway, NYU's Ehrman Medical Library staff stepped up and provided extensive support to ensure that the transition from one RML to another took place smoothly. Tania Bardyn, Assistant Director Affiliated Libraries, provided network membership and DOCLINE support; Gregg Headrick, Web Services Librarian, provided technology support; William Spivey, Education and Outreach Librarian, provided instructional support and Abigail Kennedy-Grant, Public Services Assistant, provided administrative and exhibits support.

Starting a new RML "from scratch" is a tremendous challenge! We benefited enormously from the overwhelming support of colleagues in other regions as well as the staff of the National Network Office at the National Library of Medicine.
