Executive summary

Staff Changes

The Associate Director position, which was posted in the second quarter, continues to remain vacant. Candidates were scheduled to interview in February. Arpita Bose, Outreach and Communications Coordinator, continues to serve as the interim Associate Director.

Major Accomplishments

MAR participated in a mid-contract site visit from the National Library of Medicine on December 9, 2008. The major purpose of the site visit was to assess MAR's progress towards meeting the contract goals. The site visit included three components: a meeting with NYU Medical Center's institutional administrators, a program review conducted by the MAR staff, and a network member feedback session. The final report from the site visit has been posted to the MAR web site (http://nnlm.gov/mar/about/pdf/marsitevisitreport.pdf). MAR will use the feedback from the site visit report to inform our work toward the contract goals in the current contract

Challenges

The RML has been operating with an understaffed office in the absence of a full-time Associate Director. It will be a challenge to meet all our external and internal commitments until we are again fully staffed.
