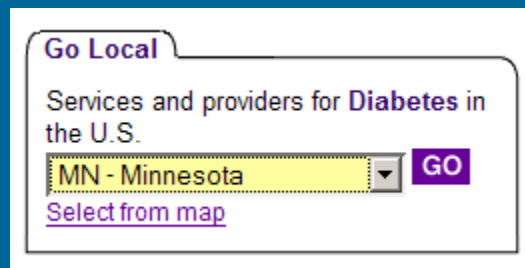


# Your link to health services in the Land of 10,000 Lakes

**My Health Minnesota → Go Local** is a free, online database of health services throughout Minnesota. It's linked to **MedlinePlus.gov**, a free website from the National Library of Medicine that provides trusted, reliable health information.

You can access My Health Minnesota → Go Local by searching for health information on MedlinePlus and linking to Minnesota from any of the health topics pages. For example, from the page for diabetes, you can link to related services in Minnesota using the Go Local drop-down menu on the right side of the page.



You can also access My Health Minnesota → Go Local directly at <http://medlineplus.gov/minnesota>.

You can use My Health Minnesota → Go Local to search by:

- Location (county, city, or zip code)
- Providers, facilities, or services
- Diseases and health issues



Not sure where to start? Select “all services,” then choose a topic of interest. For example, select diabetes, and then choose the county or city you’re looking for, or type in your zip code.

You’ll see a listing of services arranged by categories (e.g. endocrinologists, health screening programs, support groups) which provides contact information for each service.
