

The U. S. Treasury’s Financial Management Service (FMS) maintains a list of all appropriations in its Federal Account Symbols and Titles (FAST) Book, PART II (Appropriations and Other Fund Account Symbols and Titles). The FAST is available on the FMS web-site at <http://www.fms.treas.gov/fastbook/index.html>.

The Appropriation Symbol identifies the Agency, the appropriation’s period of availability and a numerical number that identifies the fund group (or the fund’s purpose). Fund accounts are grouped as: General Accounts, Revolving Accounts, Special Accounts, Deposit Accounts and Trust Accounts. The Fund account range of numbers is:

Using our USGS appropriation symbols as an example:

- 1450804** Surveys, Investigations and Research, Geological Survey
 The **14** indicates that this appropriation belongs to the Department of the Interior. All DOI bureau’s appropriations begin with 14
 The **5** indicates that this appropriation is available for one year (2005)
0804 indicates that this is a General Fund Account with the U.S. Treasury
- 145/60804** The **5/6** in this appropriation indicates that the funds are available for two years (2005 to 2006)
- 14X0804** The “**X**” indicates that the appropriation is available until expended (This is a No-Year Account)

Using other DOI Bureau's Appropriations

14X0680

Water and Related Resources, Bureau of Reclamation

The **14** indicates that this appropriation belongs to the Department of the Interior. In this case it is BOR.

The "**X**" indicates that this appropriation is available until expended.

0680 indicates that this is a General Fund Account with the U.S. Treasury

14X1109

Management of Lands and Resources: Bureau of Land Management

The **14** indicates that this appropriation belongs to the Department of the Interior, in this case it is BLM

The “**X**” indicates that the appropriation is available until expended (This is a No-Year Account)

1109 classifies the account as a General Fund Account

14_1109

The “blank” where the year is indicates that this may be an annual fund or it maybe a multi-year appropriation. BLM would need to identify the year on any agreements that they send to the USGS for work to be performed. *Example: If this money is available over two years, BLM would show the appropriation on an agreement as: **145/61109**.*

14X1641

North America Wetlands Conversation Fund, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service

The **14** indicates that this appropriation belongs to the Department of the Interior, in this case it is the FWS

The “**X**” indicates that the appropriation is available until expended (This is a No-Year Account)

1641 classifies the account as a General Fund Account.

14_1641

The “blank” where the year is indicates that this may be an annual fund or it maybe a multi-year appropriation. FWS would need to identify the year on any agreements that they send to the USGS for work to be performed. *Example: If this money is available over two years, FWS would show the appropriation on an agreement as: **145/61641**.*
