SUBJECT: Personnel Problems

I received the following chronology of events from Linda Tripp's supervisors. I have had several discussions with Ms Tripp, as have Mr. Blacklow, Lynn Reddy (Director for Programs and Community Relations) and Celia Hoke (Deputy Director). In my conversations, she has been courteous but she definitely feels mistreated and seems to expect much more than her co-workers. But the fact is that she has been a disruptive force since her arrival and nothing we do seems to assuage her.

I think it's important to note that the Directorate to which she is assigned has the highest number of political appointees (including the Director) and, historically, has successfully integrated all types of personalities and professional backgrounds into its operations. For whatever reason, it's not working with Ms. Tripp. Here's just a short laundry list of examples of the almost daily discord in the office:

- Linda arrives for first day of work; doesn't like her office space; dashes off an E-mail stating it isn't what was "promised" her. Also makes issue of parking pass.
- Linda ignores Susan Wallace when she tries to explain how things are done and turns her back. Susan suggests introducing Linda to key operatives in SecDef/DepSec offices. Linda declines, preferring to set up her own appointments to meet these people on "equal footing."
- Director provides list of Media activities to Susan and Linda and asks them to work out a division of labor for her approval upon return from leave
- Mix-up about Linda's personnel papers while Lynn's on leave. Linda is rude to Deputy Director and writes her a nasty E-Mail accusing her of keeping her personal docs
- Cliff and Celia decide Susan Wallace should go to WH to assist NSC in monitoring Haiti news. Linda writes accusatory E-Mail to Deputy Director, indicating she is better qualified than Susan and she is being treated unfairly
- Linda does OJT with another action officer for Morning Shows. Arrives at Pentagen at 6:30 am. All goes well. Linda asks Deputy Director about receiving overtime. She is told professionals (GS-13 to 15) are not normally authorized overtime pay; must take comp time. Also told that staying after 5:00 pm, as necessary, is SOP for professional staff

- Linda writes E-Mail to FO and DPRC; says DoD can't legally expect staff to stay beyond their 8-hour work day without some sort of compensation; anyway, she has family responsibilities and needs to leave promptly at 5 pm (and does, each day, exiting the back door so no one knows)
- Linda starts her "best defense is a good offense" tactic; won't speak to co-workers or exchange greeting -- unless she needs something, then all's fine
- Linda sends another E-Mail to FO and DPRC Director about her work space; she accuses <u>political discrimination</u> as LTCs have more space than she, a political appointee GS-15
- Linda and Susan won't work out division of labor and things are difficult about who
 is doing what. Lynn divides Media Responsibilities, giving each some broadcast
 and some print areas. Both unhappy, but after initial complaint, Susan buckles
 down; Linda vents declaring to Susan "I won't do Morning Shows, you'll see"; sends
 more E-mail to FO and Lynn stating dissatisfaction.
- Linda vents angrily to Susan on a continuing basis; finally LTC Ogilvie next cubicle tells them both the situation is embarrassing, unprofessional, and affects him and those nearby in DPC; to cut it out or work it out
- Director asks both Linda and Susan to check out with her each day before leaving for final update on media requests; Linda doesn't and won't; says she can't find Lynn, or that Lynn should ask Susan since she stays longer, or simply sends Lynn an E-mail saying she's leaving
- Linda refuses (not verbally but by practice) to give Director update reports or event cards for input before they go to front office or SecDef/DepSec; sends things directly-- anything and everything
- Columbus Day weekend: Linda won't answer her phone, thereby requiring Susan to come in Sat/Sun/Mon to take care of Linda's as well as her responsibilities. On Tuesday she says her answering machine is broken
- On Tues, Linda is asked to stay and produce card for Deutch Morning Show.
 Declines because her car is broken and she must take 5:30 bus; can 't stay even to prepare event card
- Linda assists DATSD in setting up SecDef Morning Shows from Middle East; leaves at 5 pm without providing him an info card to fax to SecDef/ATSD(PA) traveling party. Mr. Blacklow calls Linda at home; daughter takes message. At 7pm, Blacklow calls back. No answer -- calls Susan to fill in. Next day, Linda says daughter forgot to give her Willie's message & answering machine still broken.

- Director decides to reassign duties since Linda is unwilling -- won't -- make herself available for Morning shows. Linda doesn't like new division of labor any more than the first; sends another nasty E-Mail to FO and Director stating her dissatisfaction and claiming discrimination because she is a single parent.
- On Friday, Linda sends Director E-mail stating that she's leaving early because her cat is sick - and leaves, without seeing Director, Deputy Director, or saying anything to anyone
- Linda and Susan were asked to take beepers for weekend. Mr. Blacklow asks Linda for her beeper number when he sees her at Newsmaker Saturday. Linda says she doesn't have one because she doesn't know where to get one

Essentially, Linda is a GS-15 public affairs officer who:

- doesn't like her office space
- doesn't like her duties
- won't perform her assignments
- won't do as Lynn asks
- thinks her responsibilities are only 8:30 -5PM
- isn't nice to co-workers
- lends a disruptive manner to the office
- doesn't want to be here

The impact of all this has very negatively affected the DPCR office atmosphere where AOs previously worked together and helping each other out. Dealing with the constant barrage of nasty E-mail is ridiculous, time-consuming and disruptive.





SAN MARINO, Calif. (AP) Paula Jones announced today she will fight her sex harassment lawsuit against President Clinton with lawyers from Dallas and money raised by a conservative organization in Virginia. And the lawyers said they are not interested in settling out of court.

Mrs. Jones stood with her spokeswoman, Susan Carpenter-McMillan,

for the announcement and made only brief comments.

"I'm excited about the future. Why should I be scared?" Mrs.

Jones said.

She will be represented by the Dallas firm of Rader, Campbell, Fisher & Pyke. Her previous lawyers, Joe Cammarata and Gilbert

Davis, recently withdrew from the case after years of work.
In a statement, the new lawyers said they were ``retained as litigation counsel, not as special settlement counsel. ... We

intend to vigorously prepare it for trial."

In a court of law, there are no presidents and no plebeians all parties are equal in the eyes of justice," the statement said.

The spokeswoman said the new lawyers chose the conservative Rutherford Institute of Charlottesville, Va., for fund-raising after Mrs. Jones made it clear she could not afford to pay.

This law firm is willing to go to trial. ... That's what Paula

has always wanted," Carpenter-McMillan said.

The Rutherford Institute describes itself as a nonprofit legal and educational organization that specializes ``in the defense of

religious liberty and human rights.

It has taken the cases of a Virginia schoolboy whose teachers barred him from bringing Rush Limbaugh books to class and a woman who was not allowed to place a nativity scene outside a Fairfax County, Va., government building.

Asked about Mrs. Jones' new lawyers and the conservative financing for her case, White House press secretary Mike McCurry said, "I don't think that's particularly surprising. But as to who she selects as her legal representation, that's a matter for her to decide.'

Mrs. Jones claims Clinton exposed himself to her while he was Arkansas governor and she worked for a state economic office. The encounter allegedly occurred in May 1991 in a Little Rock, Ark., hotel room.

Clinton denies her allegations. The trial is set to begin in May.

Cammarata and Davis withdrew from the case Sept. 8 after

disagreement with Mrs. Jones over a settlement.

They recently served notice that they hold a lien for \$800,000 in hourly fees if Mrs. Jones is awarded attorneys fees in any settlement or court resolution of her suit.

Carpenter-McMalan said Mrs. Jones would only settle of Clinton publicly apologized.

'It has to be clear that she did nothing wrong,''

SAN MARINO, Calif. (AP) Paula Jones announced today she will fight her sex harassment lawsuit against President Clinton with lawyers from Dallas and money raised by a conservative organization in Virginia. And the lawyers said they are not interested in settling out of court.

Mrs. Jones stood with her spokeswoman, Susan Carpenter-McMillan,

for the announcement and made only brief comments.

"I'm excited about the future. Why should I be scared?" Mrs.

Jones said.

She will be represented by the Dallas firm of Rader, Campbell, Fisher & Pyke. Her previous lawyers, Joe Cammarata and Gilbert Davis, recently withdrew from the case after years of work.

In a statement, the new lawyers said they were `retained as litigation counsel, not as special settlement counsel. ... We

intend to vigorously prepare it for trial."

"In a court of law, there are no presidents and no plebeians all parties are equal in the eyes of justice," the statement said.

The spokeswoman said the new lawyers chose the conservative Rutherford Institute of Charlottesville, Va., for fund-raising after Mrs. Jones made it clear she could not afford to pay.

`This law firm is willing to go to trial. ... That's what Paula

has always wanted," Carpenter-McMillan said.

The Rutherford Institute describes itself as a nonprofit legal and educational organization that specializes `in the defense of religious liberty and human rights."

It has taken the cases of a Virginia schoolboy whose teachers barred him from bringing Rush Limbaugh books to class and a woman who was not allowed to place a nativity scene outside a Fairfax

County, Va., government building.

Asked about Mrs. Jones' new lawyers and the conservative financing for her case, White House press secretary Mike McCurry said, `I don't think that's particularly surprising. But as to who she selects as her legal representation, that's a matter for her to decide!'

Mrs. Jones claims Clinton exposed himself to her while he was Arkansas governor and she worked for a state economic office. The encounter allegedly occurred in May 1991 in a Little Rock, Ark., hotel room.

Clinton denies her allegations. The trial is set to begin in May.

Cammarata and Davis withdrew from the case Sept. 8 after disagreement with Mrs. Jones over a settlement.

They recently served notice that they hold a lien for \$800,000 in hourly fees if Mrs. Jones is awarded attorneys fees in any settlement or court resolution of her suit.





Clinton's thick, gray thatch ever-so-slightly thinning

WASHINGTON (AP) If White House woes are tempting President Clinton to tear his hair out, he had better keep his hands off: The presidential pate is thinning ever so slightly.

Clinton arrived in Washington four years ago with a full head of wavy, graying hair. It has grown silvery over the years more presidential, if anything. But what is this?

On closer inspection, the main man's mane is on the wane. In the right light and at certain camera angles the pink flesh of Clinton's head shines through his feathered hairdo. Thick thatches of hair in front and on the sides give way to thinner trails atop and back.

So the Baby Boomer president, who succumbed to reading glasses several years ago, now faces another hairy hurdle of middle age.

With his hair hiatus just barely noticeable, nobody is making fun of the 50-year-old Clinton. Certainly not Vice President Al

Gore, whose bald spot is growing fast.

Though Gore studiously avoids getting his hairless crown photographed, aides insist the vice president is not bothered.

'It's all part of reinventing government," quipped spokeswoman Lorraine Voles. 'He wants 20 percent less hair."
