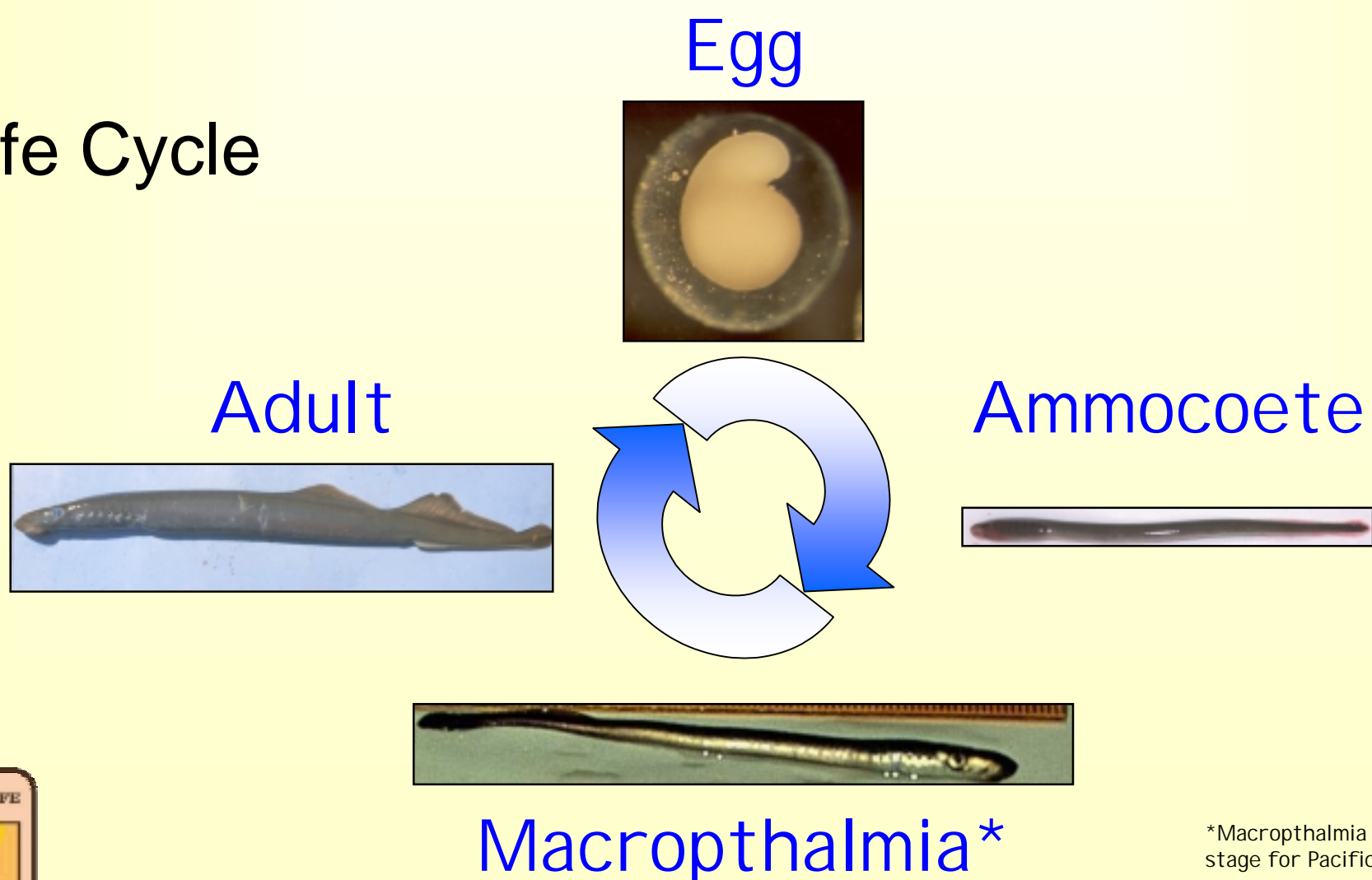
Background

- Pacific lamprey in the Columbia River Basin have declined to only a remnant of the pre-1940s populations
- Status of the western brook lamprey is unknown
- Actions are currently being considered for the recovery of Pacific lamprey populations in the Columbia River Basin

Goal

- Estimate abundance of adult lamprey that use Cedar Creek
- Evaluate spawning habitat requirements
- Determine larval distribution and habitat use
- Determine outmigrant timing
- Evaluate homing fidelity, survival rates, and ocean residence (future)

*Macrophthalmia is the outmigrant stage for Pacific lamprey
