Areas of responsibility include case investigations and prosecution assistance. Areas of inquiry include federal procurement contract and acquisition fraud, false claims, program and property fraud, bribery and larceny, embezzlement, collusion, conflicts of interest, conspiracy, anti-trust and anti-corruption involving United States Government (USG) activities. Cases are routinely nationwide or international in scope. Investigations are regularly the subject of congressional and media interest.

SIGAR was created by Congress under authority of Section 1229 National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2008 (P.L.110-181) and defines SIGAR's authority for oversight of Afghanistan reconstruction. SIGAR provides for the independent and objective conduct and supervision of audits, inspections, and investigations intended to detect and prevent waste, fraud, and abuse of USG funds appropriated for Afghanistan reconstruction.

The position is an excepted service position with the U.S. Government and is for a period of 13 months with renewal options. This position is in Arlington, VA. Temporary duty travel is required. Travel to Afghanistan is expected. Applicants must be U.S. citizens and able to secure and maintain medical and top secret security clearances. Federal retirees are exempt from pension waiver offset requirements.
