

Helpful Hints:

- It is strongly recommended that you apply to more than one academy to increase your chances of obtaining a nomination. Applying to both Senatorial offices and your Congressional office is also encouraged.
- Register with each military academy in which you have an interest; applying to one academy does not mean you have applied to all four.
- Obtain the appropriate paperwork from the academy for your medical exam. Once this is completed by your physician, return it promptly to the academy.
- Submit the completed application packet to Senator Martinez's office as soon as possible. Schools are open during the summer to obtain transcripts.
- Contact Senator Martinez's Orlando office (407-254-2573 or 866-630-7106 toll-free in Florida) to confirm that all information has been received and your file is complete.
- Throughout the selection process, emphasize your leadership ability, motivation and physical fitness. Proven track records in these areas can only enhance the strength of your candidacy.
- Keep the interview date open on your calendar. There are no make-up or alternate dates.
- Provide Senator Martinez's office with updates of SAT/ACT scores, senior year leadership positions, or important correspondence from the academy via fax (407-423-0941) or mail.
