



## **Ghana Compact Progress**

- ★ Agriculture Project: *Training of Farmer Based Organizations* (*FBOs*): The first round of FBO training, for over 300 FBOs totaling 16,700 farmers, has been completed, covering business plan development and crop productivity. A second round of training for 20,000 new farmers commenced in June.
- ★ *Irrigation Development Activity:* Approximately 5,080 hectares of land have been identified as potential sites for rehabilitated irrigation facilities. Work will begin in August 2009.
- ★ Improve Post Harvest and Value Chain Services Activity: Seven pineapple farms have been supplied with pre-coolers and a contract was signed to design a cold chain facility at Accra's Kotoka International (KIA) Airport to protect fruit from spoilage


- $\bigstar$  Improve Credit Services and Value Chain Investments Activity:
- The Bank of Ghana accredited 45 participating financial institutions including 33 rural banks, 10 commercial banks and two savings and loan banks, to lend to credit recipients. To date, \$15.9 million in credit has been provided to FBOs, farmers and agribusinesses. MiDA announced a partnership with Alliance for a Green Revolution in Africa (AGRA) and Standard Bank to support improved access of credit to small farmers.
- ★ Rural Development Project: *Community Services Activity:* In addition to 35 schools already rehabilitated, construction is underway for 30 schools in flood affected areas of northern Ghana.




