SUBJECT: Acquisition Guide Chapter 50.1 – Extraordinary Contractual Actions

**SUMMARY:** The new Acquisition Guide Chapter is being issued to update guidance for preparing, coordinating and approving a Department of Energy or a National Nuclear Security Administration contractor indemnification request pursuant to Pub. L. No. 85-804. This guidance was previously contained in Acquisition Letter (AL) 2002-04, dated July 9, 2002, which is hereby cancelled.

The updated guidance in the new Acquisition Guide Chapter includes the following changes from AL 2002-04:

- Roles and responsibilities of all parties involved in the preparation, coordination, and approval process are more clearly defined.
- A model H clause has been developed to alleviate the need for deviations, which were frequently used in the past.
- Various other model documents used in the process are now available from the Office of the Assistant General Counsel for Civilian Nuclear Programs, GC-52.
- Procedures regarding "case by case" indemnifications, and Work for Others issues have been added.
- The dollar limitation for nuclear incidents outside the United States has risen from \$100M to \$500M.
