

SUBJECT: Federal Acquisition Circular 2005-35

SUMMARY: Attached for your information is Federal Acquisition Circular 2005-35, which revokes Executive Order 13202. Executive Order 13202 had prohibited executive departments and agencies from requiring Federal contractors and subcontractors to enter into project labor agreements. New Executive Order 13502 encourages executive agencies to consider requiring the use of project labor agreements in connection with large-scale construction projects in order to promote economy and efficiency. Acquisition Guide Chapter 22.1, Labor Standards for Construction, is being updated to reflect these changes.
