


Morocco Compact Progress

- ★ Fruit Tree Productivity Project: As of May 2009, 20 Moroccan Farmer Associations across 7 provinces had planted over 50,000 olive trees on 398 hectares of erosion-prone hillsides, to provide sustainable and increased revenues to poor farmers. In addition, a broad range of stakeholders in project areas participated in an extensive and highly acclaimed public consultation to obtain feedback on Morocco's first-ever Strategic Environmental Assessment.
- ★ Financial Services Project: APP disbursed \$6.5 million to the Jaida microfinance investment fund to support Moroccan microfinance institutions.
- ★ A study is underway to understand the social and environmental impact on artisan potters of switching from traditional kilns to gas

kilns. Plans are in progress for technical assistance to assist with kiln demonstrations, bank loan applications and other tasks that will help artisans make the change to gas kilns.

- ★ Small-scale Fisheries: Over 350 people in 5 fishing communities across Morocco participated in public consultations on the construction of slipways, wholesale markets and port facilities that will be built in their communities.
- ★ Enterprise Support: Preparations are underway to begin training of up to 600 start-up enterprises in September in a pilot program to support small- and medium-size businesses.
