- 8 percent were approved exemptions by OMB
- Exemptions included:
 - Collaborative grants or multi project mechanisms
 - Agencies required agency specific forms
 - Broad Agency Announcements
 - Packages posted across quarters
 - Fellowships

Grants.gov System Update



- 2007 Production System successfully deployed September 4th
- All 147 Adobe forms are now in production
- System stability and performance is solid and improving
- Adobe Reader 8.1.1 release planned before the end of October
- Post-deployment SCR Release planned for mid-November
- Quarterly System Update Releases planned for next year starting in January
- Migration of Agency PureEdge templates to Adobe planned for completion before the end of the year.


