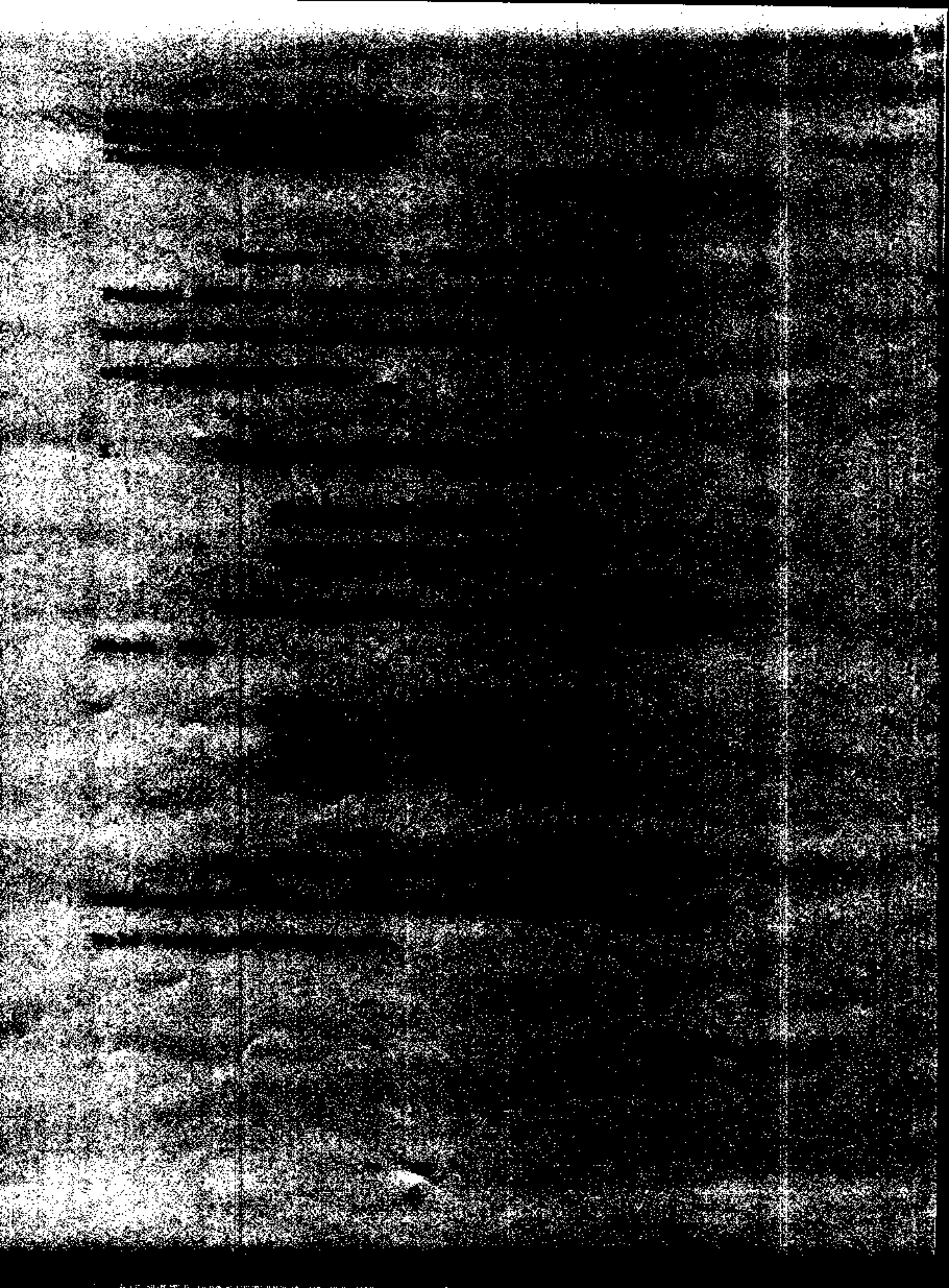

II. RELEASE FOR PUBLIC COMMENT OF VOTING
SYSTEMS STANDARDS

Agenda Document No. 01-35

She noted there would be a 60-day comment period after the publication of the notice in the *Federal Register* on the proposed revisions to the voluntary standards for computerized voting systems.
