As an alternative, the tools allow you to use national default data if no local numbers are available. By eliminating solid waste at its source, you'll go a long way towards protecting your local environment—and cut waste management costs in the process.

Installing ReduceIt

From Disk:

If your computer is operating in Windows 3.1:

- 1. Insert diskette 1.
- 2. Choose "Run" under File menu from Program Manager.
- 3. Type "a:\setup".
- 4. Choose defaults as indicated.

If your computer is operating in Windows 95:

- 1. Insert diskette 1.
- 2. Choose "Run" under the Start menu.
- 3. Type "a:\setup".
- 4. Choose defaults as indicated.

Uninstalling ReduceIt

After you have completed your work with *ReduceIt*, the program also has an uninstall feature that allows you to remove it from your hard drive.

If your computer is operating in Windows 95:

- 1. Open the folder "c:\Program Files\ReduceIt".
- 2. Click the mouse twice on the file "Unwise.exe".

If your computer is operating in Windows 3.1:

1. Click the mouse on the icon "Uninstall EPA ReduceIt".
