

### **Usability Testing Results**

- Data-Driven: Since relaunching CDC.gov in 2007, over 25 usability tests have been conducted with 750 participants, including one test with the CDC en Español Web site.
- Top Tasks Success and Satisfaction: The new CDC.gov homepage and second-level pages have improved users success of the top tasks by 62% and improved user satisfaction by 70%.

## CDC.gov and Web 2.0

CDC.gov provides content in several useful ways that facilitate customization, interactivity, collaboration, and customer participation while increasing the impact of CDC science and public health interventions.

Widgets: There are currently 11 widgets available providing RSS feeds, geographical data, emergency text messages, national statistics, and health tips in English and Spanish. Widget use has grown to more than 20 million views.

Podcasts and RSS: CDC podcasts have been expanded to 300 different topics and more than 2.4 million podcasts have been downloaded from CDC.gov to date. RSS feeds have been consumed nearly 13.9 million times.

CDC Health-e-Cards: There are currently 141 e-cards

available to send; 60,965 have been sent to date.
