Why the Audit Was Done

The Commission audits each host dommittee or municipal fund that represents a city where a publicly financed nominating convention is held. The audit seeks to determine if the committee has materially complied with the prohibitions and disclosure requirements of the election law.

Future Action

The Commission may initiate an enforcement action, at a later time, with respect to any of the matters discussed in this report.

Part I Background

Authority for Audit

This report is based on an audit of the Boston Host Committee, undertaken by the Audit Division of the Federal Election Commission (the Commission) as mandated by Section 9008.54 of Title 11 of the Code of Federal Regulations. That section states the Commission shall conduct an examination and audit of each host committee registered under 11 CFR §9008.51.

Scope of Audit

The audit examined:

- 1. The receipt of contributions from prohibited sources.
- 2. The disclosure of contributions and other receipts.
- 3. The disclosure and nature of disbursements.
- 4. The disclosure of debts and obligations.
- 5. The completeness of records.
- 6. The consistency between reported figures and bank records.
- 7. Other committee operations necessary to the review.

Inventory of Committee Records

The Audit staff routinely conducts an inventory of committee records before it begins the audit fieldwork. The Boston Host Committee's records were materially complete and the fieldwork began immediately.
