PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Fulfilling the President's Management Agenda to simplify the grants management process, Grants.gov is one of 24 Federal E-Government initiatives focused on improving access to services via the Internet. Grants.gov is the single, secure Federal website unifying over 1000 grant programs from 26 Federal grant-making agencies awarding over \$400 billion annually to the grant community including state, local and tribal governments, academia and research institutions, and not-for-profits. By transforming the Federal grants environment to a streamlined and standardized process, Grants.gov is making it easier to find and apply for Federal grants online.

Since its launch in October 2003, Grants.gov has benefited users by reducing costs associated with paper reproduction, postage and the necessary training to learn multiple grants application processes, as well as time invested in navigating numerous complex grantor systems to find and apply for Federal grants.

Today, more than 20,000 registered users and organizations are using Grants.gov to quickly find the best grant opportunities and to apply for grants electronically. 70% of grant communities surveyed agree that Grants.gov makes the grants process better.

SITE FEATURES

See what's new at Grants.gov – from secure registration and enhanced search capabilities to round-the-clock user support.

One Stop Access – Register just once for secure access to submit grant applications to all 26 Federal grant-making agencies. In 3 simple steps, users are ready to apply.

Downloadable Applications – Complete applications offline when and where convenient and easily distribute them via email as an attachment. Built-in data quality checks and tips help to facilitate application completion.

Online Submission – Click the "Submit" button, activated when an application is complete to electronically send it to the agency. Check the status of the application online - 24 hours a day.


Advanced Search Options – Search a wider selection of grants, from broad to specific subject area searches.

Online Tools – Access FAQs, quick reference guides and online demonstrations of the application process. Plus, link to grantwriting resources and other helpful guides.


