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U.S. Army awards \$9.5 M performance-based acquisition for Installation Cleanup

Aberdeen Proving Ground, Md. - On February 20, 2008, the U.S. Army Environmental Command (USAEC) awarded a \$9.5M performance-based contract to ARCADIS US, Inc., Littleton, Colorado, for environmental remediation services at Radford Army Ammunition Plant, Virginia.

The nine-year task order was awarded on the ACSIM Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity Environmental Remediation Services Contract administered by the Army Contracting Agency Aberdeen Proving Ground Directorate of Contracting. The task order includes performance objectives for achieving response complete at two sites by March 31, 2010, and one site by August 31, 2010, an approved Alternate Source Demonstration at one site by March 31, 2009, and an approved Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Facility Investigation/Corrective Measures Study at a groundwater site by March 31, 2009. In addition, the objectives call for performing any operations or long-term management at the three response complete sites, where necessary, for the duration of the task order.
