Dave Freeman is an NCUA supervisory examiner headquartered in Orlando, Florida. As supervisory examiner, Dave oversees the NCUA examination and supervision program in federally insured credit unions in Tampa, South Florida, and the Caribbean. Dave transitioned into this position in 2004. Prior to that, Dave served as the Supervisory Examiner for North Florida, South Georgia and Charleston, SC.
