SUBJECT: Sustainable Range Program Environmental Activity Responsibilities Matrix

1. To ensure the continued use of training ranges and land assets, more clearly defined funding guidance among Office of Assistant Chief of Staff for Installation Management (OACSIM) proponents regarding environmentally-related activities is needed.

2. Currently, disconnects within OACSIM programs create gaps and overlaps for the programming and funding of environmentally-related range sustainment activities. Consequently, many of these requirements have not been programmed and are being dealt with during the year of execution as unfunded requirements (UFRs) at the garrison with no clear champion. Over the past several months, OACSIM staff from Environmental Programs Directorate, Facilities and Housing Directorate, and Plans and Operations Division worked to clarify these gaps and overlaps and to identify the most appropriate proponent for those activities (encl 1).

3. The outcome of these efforts was the Sustainable Range Program Environmental Activity Responsibilities Matrix (SRP Matrix). The matrix clarifies responsibilities for funding environmentally-related sustainable range requirements, and identifies which proponent will program these requirements beginning in Budget Estimate Submission Program Objective Memorandum (BESPOM) FY 08-13 and champion any UFR in the year of execution and for BESPOM.

4. The OACSIM staff has identified the needed policy guidance clarifications to resolve the funding gaps and overlap redundancies. The next step is to modify and/or clarify guidance documents to implement the agreed upon responsibilities as outlined in the SRP matrix prior to FY06.

5. The funding guidance clarifications identified in the enclosed matrix are approved (encl 2), and I direct OACSIM staff to implement them immediately.
