Many motion picture stars, sports celebrities, and business and political leaders participated in campaigns along with civic groups including the Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts. This photograph shows the "Scouts Victory Salute" during the daylong celebration of the army service forces "Weapons of War" exhibit in Central Park in conjunction with the Fifth War Loan for

World War II. The scouts, representing troops from the greater New York Council, rendered salutes to their bigger brothers and sisters in service. A detachment of WACs and MP's from the 716th Military Police Battalion received the salutes. Speakers of the day included Mrs. Oscar B. Rogers, Secretary of the Girl Scout Council, and William H. Fouch, President of the Greater New York Council.
