In 1972 Cindy started her credit union career at NAVY FEDERAL CU as an inquiry clerk at the Navy Yard in Washington DC until NFCU decided to relocate their main facility to Merrifield, Va.

Cindy worked at other credit unions in the Washington DC area until 1986 when she saw an opening just a few miles from her home in Upper Marlboro, Maryland as the Assistant Manager of Prince George's Employees FCU.

She continued her education by attending CUNA MANAGEMENT SCHOOL and graduated in 1989. The next 6 years were spent fine tuning her skills for the position of CEO. After the retirement of Mac Ignacio, her mentor, she was appointed CEO in January of 1995. PGEFCU's assets were \$35,000,000 with 6400 members.

On December 23, 2005 PGEFCU applied for a charter change from multi seg to community. With unprecedented speed, NCUA approved the request by February 2006, along with a name change to Prince George's Community FCU

Under Cindy's management, PGCFCU has continued to include products and services to remain competitive in the demanding financial arena of the Washington DC area. Her commitment to credit unions has produced the growth of PGCFCU to support over \$85,000,000 in assets with 12,000 Members.

She remains very active in the credit union movement, including currently serving on the MDDCCUA Board of Directors and the AWARDS COMMITTEE with the Credit Union National Association.
