### About the Regional Computer Forensics Laboratory Program

The Regional Computer Forensics Laboratory (RCFL) Program is built on partnerships between the FBI and other law enforcement agencies at the federal, state and local levels operating within a geographic area. An RCFL is a one-stop, single service forensics laboratory and training devoted to the examination of digital evidence in support of criminal investigations and to the detection and prevention of terrorist acts. Each laboratory is equipped with a modern classroom and offers coursework about digital forensics for all skill levels.

Digital forensics is the application of science and engineering to the recovery of digital evidence in a legally acceptable method. The primary forensics responsibilities of an RCFL are to—

- Conduct a comprehensive examination of digital evidence
- Provide a complete and timely report to the contributor
- Provide testimony as needed
- Act as a regional focal point for digital evidence issues.
