Program Features and Requirements: The Catalog's database contains information submitted by 57 Federal departments and agencies on over 1,400 Federal programs. The website is updated bi-weekly with information received from Federal agencies. Currently, programs in the Catalog include grants, direct payments for use of beneficiary, loans, insurance, property donation/sale/exchange, Federal counseling, training programs, and use of Federal property, facilities and equipment. There is a search tool on the website. There are some helpful tips on writing grant proposals featured in the catalog.
