The NCUA is accepting applications for the Community Development Revolving Loan Fund's loan program and grant initiatives. Eligible low-income credit unions are able to apply for the following grant initiatives:

- Student Internship Initiative
- Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) Initiative
- Staff, Official, and Board Member Training Initiative
- Outreach and Partnering Initiative
- Building Internal Capacity Initiative

#### Loans

Eligible low-income credit unions may apply for up to \$300,000. Loans have a maturity of 5 years and have a 1 percent interest rate.
