The House will meet at 12:30 p.m. for Morning Hour and 2:00 p.m. for legislative business. **Votes are postponed until 6:30 p.m.**

Suspensions (8 bills):

The House is scheduled to consider 8 Suspension bills. Suspension bills are debatable for **40 minutes each**, may not be amended, and require two-thirds majority for passage.

- 1) H.Con.Res. 27** - Condemning the selection of Libya to chair the United Nations Commission on Human Rights (Hyde/Lantos-IR)
- 2) H.Con.Res. 22** - Honoring Czech Republic President Vaclav Havel (Kind-IR)
- 3) H.Res. ____** - Commending Israel on their elections (Cantor-IR)
- 4) H.R. 337** - To extend certain hydro-electric licenses in the State of Alaska (Don Young - E&C)
- 5) H.R. 397** - To reinstate and extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Illinois (Shimkus -E&C)
- 6) H.J.Res. 19** - Recognizing the 92nd birthday of Ronald Reagan (Cox-Gov't Reform)
- 7) H.Res. 41** - Congratulating the University of Portland women's soccer team for winning the 2002 NCAA Division I national championship (Blumenauer - E&W)
- 8) S. 141** - To improve the calculation of the Federal subsidy rate with respect to certain small business loans, and for other purposes (Snowe-Budget/Small Business)
