<b>Offered by:</b>	National Credit Union Foundation (NCUF)
<b>Target Credit Union Participants:</b>	Credit unions wishing to promote and improve financial services for consumers.
<b>Eligible Programs for Credit Unions:</b>	Biz Kids, REAL Solutions, Development Education, Social Impact Management, Affordable Mortgage Lending
<b>Program Objective:</b>	The NCUF, an affiliate of the Credit Union National Association (CUNA), funds national projects that support their mission to promote and improve consumer financial independence through credit unions.
<b>Credit Union Eligibility:</b>	All credit unions are eligible to participate in the NCUF's programs.
<b>Program Features and Requirements:</b>	<p>The NCUF's most prominent programs include the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Biz Kids — the NCUF sponsors this new Public Broadcasting System series.</li><li>• REAL Solutions—This program assists state leagues and national credit union organizations to promote credit unions as a viable and sustainable choice for consumers.</li><li>• Development Education—A six day <i>Credit Union Development Educators</i> class that teaches the credit union's seven cooperative principles and the philosophy of "People Helping People."</li><li>• Social Impact Management Institute—A leadership training experience that empowers credit union leaders.</li><li>• Intermediary Mortgage Lending— the NCUF is a national intermediary for the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and the U.S. Department of Agriculture.</li><li>• Grants—The foundation provides grants to credit unions serving people of modest means with their products and services.</li></ul>
