Program

Objective: The Council is a formal, interagency body empowered to prescribe uniform principles, standards, and report forms for the federal examination of financial institutions by various agencies and to make recommendations to promote uniformity in the supervision of financial institutions.

Eligibility: All credit unions can access the FFIEC's resources.

Program

Features: The FFIEC website provides the following tools for financial institutions:

- Press Releases pertaining to institutional activities.
- Geocoding/mapping system: Obtain demographic information (mainly population and income data) from this section.
- Home Mortgage Disclosure Act (HMDA) Data Reports: Provides access to HMDA aggregate reports produced from information submitted to the FFIEC.
- Financial Report: Provides detailed financial information for all FDIC-insured institutions.
