## HUD Spends \$327,078 in Stimulus Funds on its Own Office Furniture

- ➤ The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), an agency within the Department of Health and Human Services (HUD), spent \$326,078.12 in stimulus funds on a contract to "purchase and install 98 workstations." That works out to a total cost of \$3,327 per workstation. HRSA will also get 20 "Conference Chairs in Grade A Fabric with Casters" as part of the deal.
- ➤ Under the stimulus, HRSA received \$2.5 billion in funding to be distributed to community health centers (\$500 million), construction and acquisition of equipment at community health centers (\$1.5 billion), and health professions training (\$500 million). No word on how 20 conference room chairs covered in "Grade A" fabric, and 98 work stations for government bureaucrats, s an essential part of dispensing these funds.
- ➤ Under the House Republican Stimulus Alternative, \$326,000 in taxpayer money would not have been spent on office furniture for Washington bureaucrats.
