Ms. Rebecca Leng is the Assistant Inspector General for Financial and Information Technology Audits at the U.S. Department of Transportation. In her current position, she is responsible for overseeing financial statement audits of the Department's \$50 billion of annual spending, awards of procurement contracts, acquisition and operation of information technology systems, and security protection over the air traffic control system.

In 2003, Ms. Leng was appointed to the Information Security and Privacy Advisory Board, which was established by the Computer Security Act of 1987 and the Federal Information Security Management Act of 2002. The Board is responsible for advising the National Institute of Standards and Technology and the Office of Management and Budget on information security and privacy issues concerning the Federal Government.

Ms. Leng joined the U.S. Department of Transportation in 1991. Prior to that, she worked for private companies and an accounting firm. She received her master's degree from the Ohio State University and her baccalaureate's degree from the National Taiwan University. She is a Certified Public Accountant (CPA) and a Certified Information Systems Auditor (CISA).
