Subject: Thrift Savings Plan Video

The Federal Retirement Thrift Investment Board has revised the TSP Video to provide updated information about the Thrift Savings Plan. This video supersedes the TSP Video that was developed in 1998; agencies should discard their copies of the old video.

The 11-minute video explains the basic features of the TSP in an animated format. It should be especially useful for informing newly eligible FERS1 employees about the benefits and advantages of contributing to the TSP. Agencies should use the video to publicize the TSP during open seasons; they may also wish to use the video in retirement planning seminars and other employee gatherings.

The video comes in three VHS formats: standard play, open-captioned, and continuous play. A limited supply is now also available in CD-ROM, with the standard and opencaptioned versions on one disk. For a limited time, agency representatives who do not receive paper bulletins but would like a complimentary copy of the standard play version on VHS can request one through the TSP Web site from the Announcements page of the Agency Representatives section.
