

Employer Status Determination
Transportation Inspection Agency Inc.

This is the determination of the Railroad Retirement Board regarding the continuing status of Transportation Inspection Agency Inc. (TIA) as an employer under the Railroad Retirement Act (45 U.S.C. § 231, et seq.) (RRA) and the Railroad Unemployment Insurance Act (45 U.S.C. §351, et seq.) (RUIA). The TIA was ruled to be an employer under the Acts administered by the Board effective April 20, 1987.

TIA terminated its operations on or about May 31, 1996. TIA's annual report for 1996 shows that it last compensated its remaining employee on August 31, 1996. TIA disposed of its assets upon its dissolution as a corporation. TIA's personnel and financial records were given to CSXT Transportation for retention.

In accordance with the information summarized above, it is the Board's determination that Transportation Inspection Agency, Inc. ceased to be an employer under the RRA and RUIA as of the close of business on August 31, 1996, the last day on which it compensated an employee.
