201.1103, that the Division of Enforcement has submitted to the Commission a proposed
plan ("Distribution Plan") for the distribution of monies placed into a Fair Fund in the
above-captioned matter. On December 22, 2004, in the above-captioned matter, the
Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative and Cease-and Desist Proceedings,
Making Findings, and Imposing Remedial Sanctions and a Cease-and-Desist Order Pursuant
to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 15(b) and 21C of the Securities
Exchange Act of 1934 ("Order") (Securities Act of 1933 Release No. 8520, Securities
Exchange Act of 1934 Release No. 50910). Among other things, the Commission's Order
authorized and established the Fair Fund at issue.

THE DISTRIBUTION PLAN

The Distribution Plan provides for distribution of the disgorgement, prejudgment interest and civil penalties paid by Edward D. Jones & Co., L.P. ("Edward Jones") in this matter to all eligible customers of Edward Jones who purchased shares of mutual funds from seven Preferred Mutual Fund Families that were available for sale by Edward Jones' registered representatives from January 1, 1999 through December 31, 2004 ("Eligible Customers"). The seven Preferred Mutual Fund Families are: American

Funds, Federated Investors, Goldman Sachs Group, Hartford Mutual Funds, Lord Abbett

Funds, Putnam Investments and Van Kampen Investments. The Fair Fund consists of the

\$75 million paid by Edward Jones plus any accumulated interest. As proposed in the

Distribution Plan, if approved, eligible customers of Edward Jones would receive a pro

rata share of the Fair Fund as calculated by Edward Jones and the Fair Fund

administrator. The pro rata shares of the Fair Fund would be determined based on

information contained in Edward Jones' records and audited by the Fair Fund

administrator. Eligible customers would not need to go through a claims process.
