**ORDER DISMISSING PROCEEDINGS
WITHOUT PREJUDICE AS TO
ASIA4SALE.COM, INC.**

I.

Wherefore, Respondent Asia4Sale.com, Inc. submitted an Offer of Settlement, dated December 13, 2005 (the "Offer of Settlement"), whereby respondent promised, among other things, that it would file all of its previously delinquent Forms 10-QSB and 10-KSB for the years 2000 through 2005 by January 31, 2006 or consent to the revocation of the registration of all of its securities pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Exchange Act of 1934. In the Offer of Settlement, respondent provided the Division of Enforcement until February 10, 2006 to object the any filings respondent may make pursuant to the Offer of Settlement;

Wherefore, the Commission accepted respondent's Offer of Settlement on February 7, 2006;

Wherefore, respondent Asia4Sale.com, Inc. filed each of its previously delinquent forms 10-QSB and 10-KSB on or before January 31, 2006, and the Division of Enforcement raised no objections pursuant to the terms contained in the Offer of Settlement as to the substantive content of respondent's filings;

Therefore, for good cause shown:

IT IS ORDERED THAT this proceeding is hereby DISMISSED as to Asia4sale.com, Inc. without prejudice.
