#### **Executive summary**

With year 02 budget approval we moved ahead with several projects this quarter. Funding outreach was a high priority. We advertised and accepted applications for express outreach awards, outreach projects, technology awareness awards, exhibits and training awards. In May, we requested full proposals from seven applicants for our subcontracted outreach funding. In July, we approved funding for five technology improvement awards, four training awards, seven exhibit awards, five technology awareness/policy conference awards, and seven express outreach awards.

Personnel: On May 21, 2007 Beth received the President's Award for her sustained work in health literacy. On July 9, 2007 Mandy Bayer Meloy joined the staff as Community Outreach Coordinator. Her responsibilities will include working with minority faith and community organizations.

Emergency preparedness activities continued. On June 15, 2009 Beth attended the Association of North Carolina Health and Science Libraries symposium on Disaster Preparedness and Response in Medical Libraries. The symposium was held in Raleigh and drew about 20 attendees, most from North Carolina. Dan Wilson, chair of our emergency preparedness task force, presented at our June hospital library web conference. Janice continued to attend emergency preparedness teleconferences with NN/LM staff.

Advocacy activities this quarter included attending state health science association meetings to update members on NLM and NN/LM activities as well as site visits to potential member libraries. Janice and Toni sent an abstract for a poster on SE/A advocacy activities to both the MAC and Southern Chapters of the Medical Library Association for consideration for their fall meetings.

Distance learning activities are starting to increase. Terri is working with Michelle Eberle of Region 8 worked to enter content for *Beyond an Apple a Day* as a distance learning opportunity. This quarter Dale offered his Linkout class via Adobe Connect and Toni held a web conference for hospital librarians.

#### Update of ongoing major projects (funded at $\geq$ \$15,000)

## University of Maryland, Health Sciences and Human Services Library – Health Information Outreach to Underserved Populations in Baltimore, MD

A total of 410 individuals were trained through July 31, 2007, during large events, like the African American Heritage Festival and an Opportunity Summit for community school mental health providers, as well as many smaller events. Most, but not all, activities took place in Baltimore City. Trainees included healthcare professionals, students and members of the general public. Report indicates they were very successful in reaching members of minority populations.

#### George Washington University – Connecting for Health Literacy

Principal Investigator and Co-Principal Investigator met with nurses to plan a health literacy meeting and celebration for October. HIPS members met with teachers, staff and students at the Academy of Hope

and School of Tomorrow to discuss content and format of health curriculum. HIPS visited Max Robinson and Homes for Hope every Thursday to teach Internet health information resources. A *Homes for Hope* health information student has been hired to teach health information classes at two other programs. Monthly hands-on trainings continue. 25 trainings occurred over the summer and 29 outreach activities.

#### Western Maryland AHEC – West Virginia Information Outreach II

During this quarter, training was developed and provided for 19 students of and 2 residential assistants to the West Virginia University Health Careers Opportunity Program (HCOP) in Morgantown, WV. The HCOP program is a six-week residential program offering educational experiences inside and outside the classroom for two groups of students: Preliminary Education students who are incoming college freshmen working to gain entry into a health discipline and the Facilitating Entry students, who are sophomore and juniors that are preparing to apply to health professional schools. Project staff also trained a group of 19 students enrolled in Western Maryland AHEC's Exploring Careers in Health Occupations (ECHO) program. ECHO is designed to provide 9th through 11th grade students with an opportunity to explore the vast options in the health professional field.

## Baptist Hospital - Health Touch: Information at Your Fingertips

Project was delayed due to family leave. An extension was discussed and will be requested officially when the PI returns. Progress letter was received and new due dates for reports sent to subcontractor.

#### University of Virginia - Evidence-based Public Health Informatics Training for Public Health Practitioners in Central and Southwestern Virginia

During this quarter, project staff conducted two training sessions. A total of 29 participants attended the sessions. As a result of the training, they decided to update the public health manual and the PowerPoint presentation. Additional sessions were set for the next quarter.

## Anson Community Hospital - Linking Community Care and Health Education

Project staff had a very busy quarter. The computer equipment was installed at the churches and community centers. Training was conducted for 48 health advocates.
