## Online Databases A-Z

### Accessing databases:

- ▶ On site at libraries: Databases are available through public access computers. A SmartCard™ is required for computer use. *Note: Downloadable audiobooks, eBooks and video currently are not available on library computers.*

### **Auralog – TELL ME MORE®**

This language learning system offers users full immersion and speech recognition technology. Learn to speak your next language in the same environment as you learned your first. Learn Spanish, English, French, German and Italian by focusing on speech, comprehension, reading and writing. (To access, login with your name and barcode to create an account.)

### **Auto Repair Reference Center**

A full-text database providing information on repair procedures, wiring diagrams, service bulletins, service recalls, labor and quick tips for automobiles, trucks and SUVs produced by most major manufacturers from 1954 to 2008.

### **Biography Resource Center and Who's Who**

Comprehensive database of biographical information on over 320,000 people from throughout history, around the world, and across all disciplines and subject areas. Also includes full-text articles from hundreds of periodicals. Search for people based on one or more personal facts such as birth and death year, nationality, ethnicity, occupation or gender, or combine criteria to create a highly-targeted custom search. With the Complete Marquis Who's Who(R), find quick reference information on an additional 900,000 people.

### **Business and Company ASAP**

Coverage: 1980 – current. Providing researchers with information on companies, markets and industries. From market trends, mergers and acquisitions to current management theory and company overviews. Access business and trade journals, newspapers and company directory profiles with full text and images.

### **Business and Company Resource Center**

### **Downloadable Audiobooks**

Select from 2600+ fiction and nonfiction titles to listen to from your computer, MP3 player, iPod or compatible hand-held device. Collection includes bestsellers, self-help, genre fiction, classics, religion and spirituality, business and career, current events travel and juvenile titles. Great listening is just a few clicks away, when you have a valid library card, internet access, and free software downloaded to your computer or device. *Note: Downloadable audiobooks, eBooks and video currently are not available on library computers.*

### **Downloadable eBooks**

Using Adobe Digital Editions, download and read eBooks on your computer, or transfer Adobe eBooks to supported versions of the Sony® Reader. Popular fiction, nonfiction, and the "best of the best" titles are yours with just a few clicks of the mouse. All that's needed for convenient eBooks downloads is a valid library card, internet access, and free software downloaded to your computer or device. *Note: Downloadable audiobooks, eBooks and video currently are not available on library computers.*

### **Downloadable Video**

Enjoy unique films and programs that you won't find anywhere else. Engaging titles available to watch from the convenience of your computer include classics, animation, documentaries, travel, foreign, horror, drama and mystery/suspense titles. *Note: Downloadable audiobooks, eBooks and video currently are not available on library computers. Video downloads are available only for high-speed internet connections, and currently are not available for Macs.*

## **SEARCHING TIPS**

With a wide variety of databases from which to choose, a little bit of planning can go a long way in making the most of your information search. The following tips are especially useful when working with *periodical*, *encyclopedia* or *reference databases*.

► **Starting out: Determine what category of information your search fits into.**

Are you researching current events? Auto repair? Business and finance? Looking for an address? Select databases that cover the pertinent subject area. In addition to the “A-Z” list of databases, the library’s “24/7 Guide” can also help you decide on a database that meets your needs.

► **Think about what the information you want to find will look like.**

This will help you identify the database features that can best support your information search. Questions to consider are:

- What time period should it cover?
- Do you need a full text article?
- Are you looking for a legal form?
- Do you want to find address or phone number?

► **Making the most of your database choice.**

When you’ve selected and have accessed the database, take a minute to read through any “about this database” information that’s provided. This will give you a quick overview of the database’s scope and coverage.

► **Be simple and direct.**

Especially when searching for articles (in newspaper, magazine or reference databases), simplicity is the way to go. Make a list of important words that describe your search topic. Databases often provide a keyword searching option. Just type in the important search words. No need to include common words and connectors such as the, and, a...

► **Revising your search.**

Sometimes your search results may seem too broad, too narrow – or otherwise off the mark. Adjusting your search words or limits can help. Consider these options:

- Change search words – to make your search more general or precise
- Use advanced search options when available
- Limit or expand the time frame for information
- Limit or expand use of search fields (full-text, headlines, abstracts/summaries)
