| <b>Criteria</b>              | <p>A removable transport enclosure is properly labeled for all covered animals if it contains:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• markings on the top and one or more sides of the enclosure</li> <li>• directional arrows indicating the upright position</li> <li>• the words "Live Animal" (see page 13.5.2)                         <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▸ in letters at least 1" in height</li> <li>▸ on top of the enclosure and on one or more sides</li> </ul> </li> </ul>   |
| <b>Species Specific</b>      | <p><b>Nonhuman Primates [3.87(f)]</b><br/>                 Removable and permanently affixed transport enclosures must contain the words "Wild Animal" or "Live Animal" in English.</p> <p><b>Marine Mammals [3.113(f)]</b><br/>                 The transport enclosure, when not permanently affixed to the cargo space, must be marked with the words "Live Animal" or "Wild Animal":</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• on top (when present), and</li> <li>• on at least one side, or</li> <li>• on all sides whenever possible</li> </ul> <p><b>Other Animals [3.137(e)]</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The words "Wild Animal" may also be used.</li> </ul> |
