

## **National Cemeteries and Soldiers Lots listed in the National Register of Historic Places and designated a National Historic Landmark**

Many of the oldest national cemeteries and soldiers lots managed by the National Cemetery Administration are recognized as historically significant by designation as a National Historic Landmark (NHL) and/or listing in the National Register of Historic Places, programs under the jurisdiction of the National Park Service, Department of the Interior.

**National Historic Landmarks** are buildings, sites, districts, structures, and objects that have been determined by the Secretary of the Interior as nationally significant in American history and culture. A nationally significant property is of exceptional value in representing or illustrating an important theme in national history. All NHLs are included in the **National Register of Historic Places**, which is the official list of the nation's historic properties worthy of preservation. Properties listed on the National Register of Historic Places are primarily of State and local significance. The nomination is frequently part of an overarching historic context such as the "Civil War Era National Cemeteries Multiple Property Submission (MPS)."

### **Federal Law**

Federal funding or licensing of activities that affect historic properties are regulated principally by Sections 106 and 110(f) of the National Historic Preservation Act. Resources designated as National Historic Landmarks require a greater level of preservation diligence, as described in 36 CFR 65.2 - Effects of designation. The law requires that Federal agencies "take into account" the effects of their undertakings on historic properties, and afford the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation an opportunity to comment on the undertaking and its effects.

### **Education**

The **Teaching with Historic Places** (TwHP) program is a component of the National Register of Historic Places. TwHP has developed lesson plans, guidance on using places to teach; professional development publications; and information encouraging educators, historians, preservationists, site interpreters, and others to work together effectively. Some NCA cemeteries have been used as the basis for lesson plans, including Dayton, Ohio, titled, "A Nation Repays Its Debt: The National Soldiers' Home and Cemetery in Dayton, Ohio."
