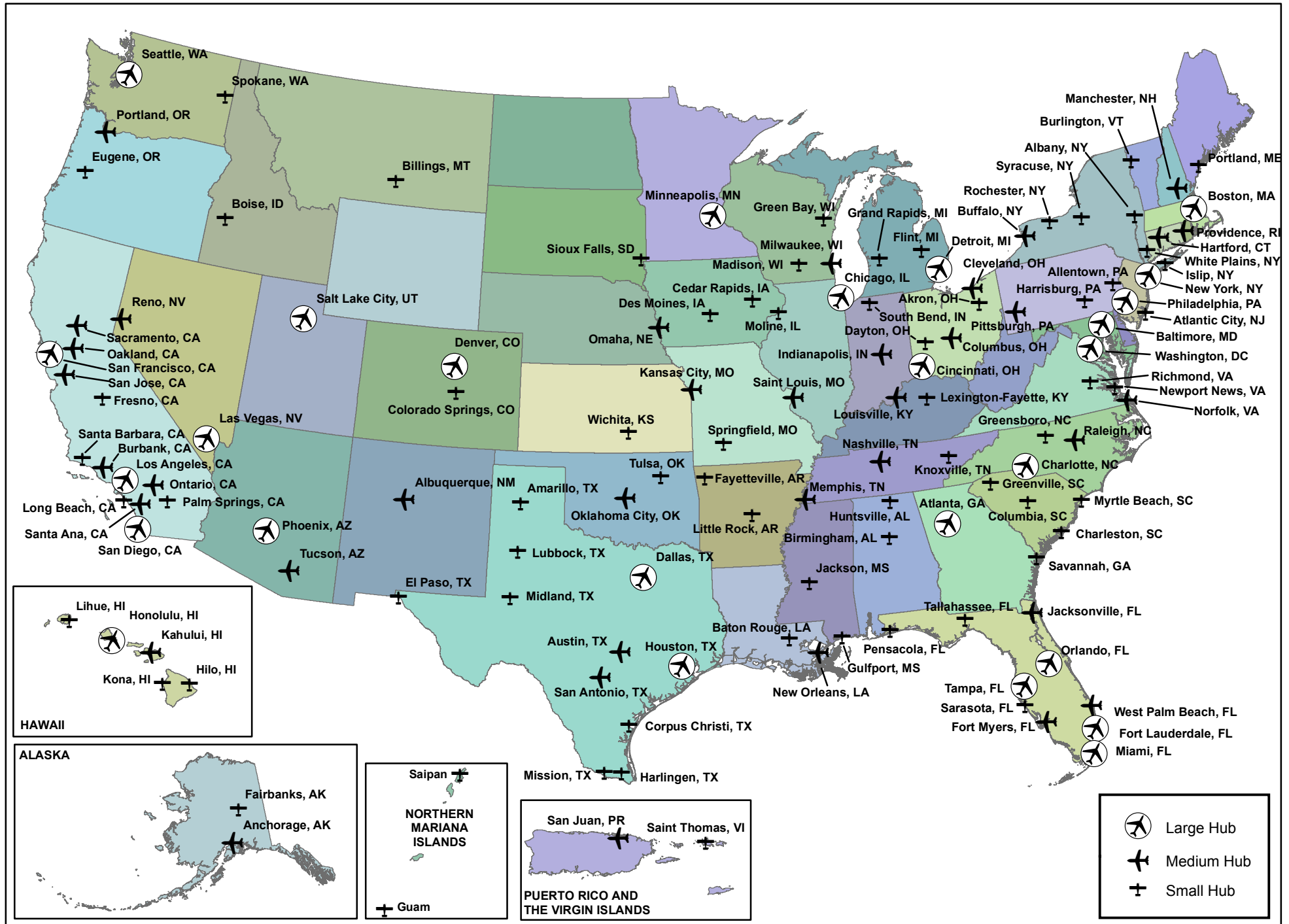




# Air Traffic Hubs 2007



NOTE: An Air Traffic Hub is a community or geographic area whose airport(s) serve at least .05% of all enplaned (boarded) passengers in the United States. All locations displayed here had a total enplanement of 30,000 or more for 2006. They are categorized based on their share of total enplaned passengers: Large, 1% or more; Medium, 0.25%–0.99%; and Small, 0.05%–0.24%. Source: BTS data as of April 2007.
