

NON-REGULATED ANIMALS	Non-regulated animals should not be inspected or mentioned on the inspection report unless there is the potential for a negative effect on the health or well-being of the regulated animal(s).
	Examples of a potential negative effect are: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• ten peafowl are roosting over the animal feed containers and contaminating the feed with feces• a horse is chasing a deer in a pasture and causing the deer to injure itself• the number of non-regulated animals is so large that the current staffing is inadequate to properly care for the regulated animals
