
SUBJECT: Referral of Contracts for Review

I request your assistance in the review of the Air Force contracts listed below. These contracts were identified during the course of an internal study I commissioned in November 2004. The study was conducted in response to admissions by Ms. Darleen Druyun, Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary for the Air Force (Acquisition and Management), from 1993 to 2002, that she may have allowed personal interests to affect her judgment on acquisition decisions she made. In this regard, Ms. Druyun identified to federal prosecutors certain specific acquisition decisions. The study I commissioned was designed to review all Air Force acquisition actions Ms. Druyun was involved in during her tenure to determine if there were any other contracts that should be further reviewed under the circumstances. The contracts identified are:

7. F-16 Mission Training Center, F33657-99-D-2025, Lockheed Martin, 2001
8. C-40 Lease & Purchase Program, F33657-02-C-0017, Boeing, 2000-2002
