## SEER Incidence and US Death Rates+ Myeloma, by Race and Sex

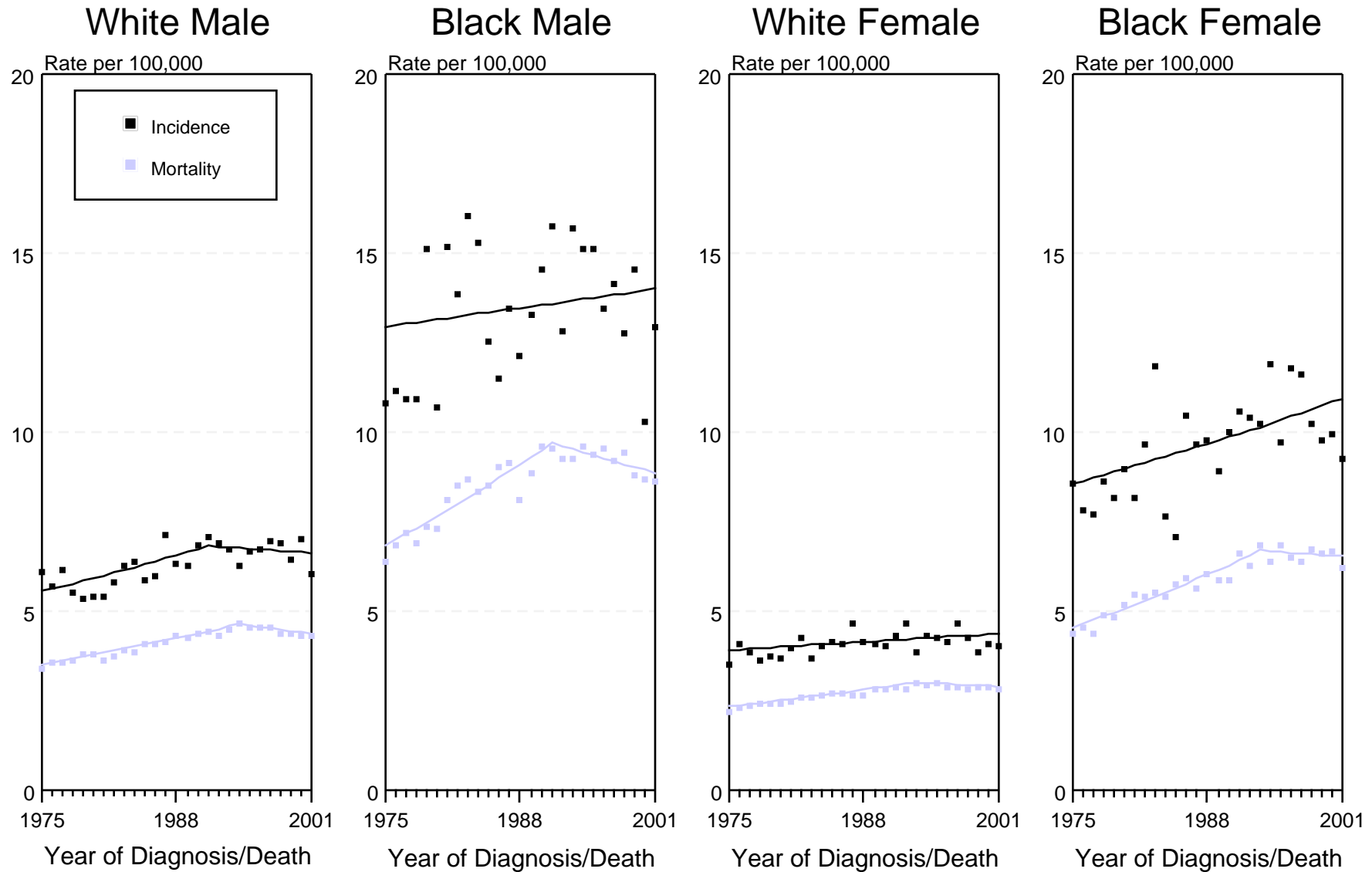
