## CONSUMER PRICE INDEX FOR THE SAN FRANCISCO AREA, JULY 2009

Regional Commissioner Richard J. Holden of the Bureau of Labor Statistics said that a 1.2 percent decrease in gasoline prices was the primary reason for the 0.5 decrease in the special aggregate index for energy in July 2009. Gasoline prices dropped 35.2 percent over the year, strongly influencing the 27.2 percent fall in overall energy prices. The household energy index increased 0.6 percent for the month, but declined 7.6 percent over the year. Within household fuels, electricity prices were unchanged for the month, yet advanced 13.1 percent for the year. The utility (piped) gas service index increased 2.8 percent from June to July, but fell 43.5 percent over the year.

Area grocery prices decreased 0.4 percent from June to July and were 1.6 percent lower than a year ago. The food at home index now stands at 224.736. This means grocery shoppers in the greater Bay Area spent \$224.74 in July for a basket of food items that cost \$100.00 in 1982-84.

The shelter index decreased 0.2 percent in the San Francisco-Oakland-San Jose area in July 2009, yet was 1.1 percent higher compared to one year earlier. Within shelter, the rent of primary residence index and the owners' equivalent rent of primary residence index were both unchanged from June to July. Over the year, the rent of primary residence index rose 3.7 percent and the owners' equivalent rent of primary residence index advanced 2.3 percent. Also included in shelter, but not part of the publication structure, are price data for lodging away from home. Local area CPI data are not seasonally adjusted.
