 Assess and avoid or mitigate the possible adverse effects of human-related developmental activities on or near the Pribilof Islands and other habitat


Objective 3

Causes of the decline/ Threats to the population



- Commercial harvest
- Parasitism and disease
- Nutritional stress
- Predation
- Habitat capacity and environmental change
 - Emigration

Causes of the decline/ Threats to the population cont'd

Human-induced factors include

- Enganglement
- Subsistence harvest
- Commercial fishing
- Pollution
- Vessel traffic, tourism
- Coastal development
- Noise
- Oil and gas activities





Research Needs

- Population biology including continuation of pup and bull counts, vital rates, spatial comparative studies, foraging ecology etc.
- Fisheries interactions
- Disease assessment/ Contaminant analyses
- Predation studies
- Ecosystem changes
- Marine debris and pollutants
- Harvest practices evaluation
- Habitat assessment

Management Actions

- Disentanglement program
- Observer programs
- Mitigation of human presence
 - Aircraft, vessel, motorized vehicles, tourism, pedestrian traffic
- Interagency consultations
- Co-management
- Education and outreach



Management Actions

- Island Sentinel program
- International partnerships
- Fisheries management
- Enforce existing regulations
- Harvest management
- Marine Debris, pollution mitigation
- Outreach ad education
- Disease vector management
 - . Dogs, rats etc.
